- 001 Tempranillo, Esencia de Fontana, 2016/17** Uclés, Spain
Intense aromas of ripe berry fruit and liquorice. Medium-bodied with beautiful balance between fruit concentration, fresh acidity and fine tannins. (B) 13.5% vol

- 002 Merlot, Honoré de Berticot, 2015/16** IGP de l'Atlantique, France
No heaviness, here is a light supple Merlot that takes its cue from many traditional light wines made in neighbouring Bordeaux. (C) 12.5% vol

- 003 Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Riserva, Tor del Colle, Botter, 2014/15** Abruzzo, Italy
Intense and concentrated on the nose with cherry flavours and notes of blackberries and liquorice. Dry and herbaceous on the palate, rounded and mouthfilling. (C) 13.5% vol *VEGAN OPTION

- 004 Pinot Noir Reserva, Aves del Sur, 2015/16** Maule Valley, Chile
Red ruby colour with violet tones. Elegant aromas of cherries, raspberries and strawberries mixed with sweet vanilla notes. Soft and rounded on the palate with smooth tannins. (B) 14% vol

- 005 Shiraz, Midday Somewhere, Hesketh, 2016/17**
South, Australia
Brilliant aromatic fruit notes balanced perfectly alongside soft vanilla hues from the quality of French oak barriques. A well-structured palate with berry, coffee, liquorice flavours giving a juicy and elegant wine style. (C) 14.5% vol
